

How to Use "Has" and "Have"

Rules:

Use "has" with singular subjects (he, she, it).

Example: She has a red balloon.

Use "have" with plural subjects (I, you, we, they).

Example: They have a big house.

"You" always takes "have", whether singular or plural.

Example: You have a lovely smile.

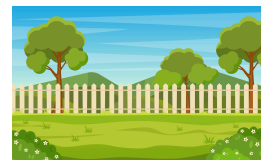
